TEST YOUR WATER

Get your water tested by a certified water treatment professional or state approved lab.



PURCHASE A WATER SOFTENER SYSTEM

After getting your water tested, speak with a water treatment professional to determine which treatment solution will meet your needs.



REGULARLY CHECK AND REPLENISH SALT

To maintain the highest quality of water, remember to check your salt levels in the brine tank and replenish when low.

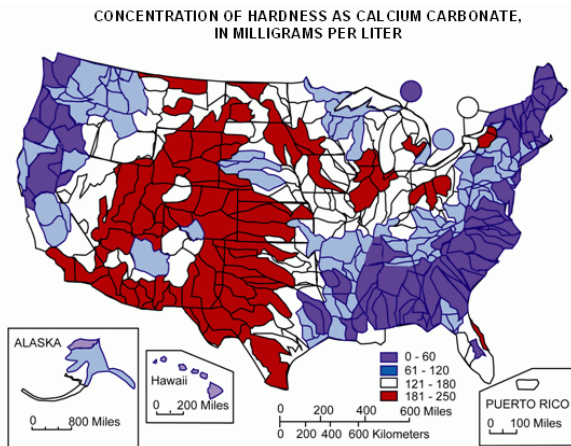

HARD WATER BASICS

Water becomes “hard” when it picks up calcium, magnesium and other minerals while traveling through rock and soil. The level of hardness differs in areas because it is dependent on how long the water is traveling through the ground and picking up minerals.

SYMPTOMS OF HARD WATER



Shorter lifespan of appliances

Hard water minerals can build up in appliances and pipes, restricting water flow.



Stained or discolored fixtures

Brown water is caused by both tealike extracts of decaying leaves and metals such as iron, manganese, and copper.



Dull/ Scratchy clothes and towels

Hard water reduces the effectiveness of soaps and detergents for laundry.



Cloudy glassware and dry skin

Hard water inhibits the ability for soaps to lather and can leave a residue on glassware, skin, and hair.
